The **IB ACIO** Syllabus 2025 is structured to evaluate candidates across analytical, general awareness, and communication skills. The **IB ACIO** Exam is conducted in **three tiers i.e. Tier 1 (Objective), Tier 2 (Descriptive), and Tier 3 (Interview)**. Tier 1 includes subjects like Current Affairs, General Studies, Reasoning, Numerical Aptitude, and English. Tier 2 focuses on Essay Writing, English Comprehension, and long answer-type questions. The descriptive and interview rounds check clarity of thought and personality.

Candidates must understand the complete Intelligence Bureau Recruitment 2025 Syllabus to prepare effectively for each stage. Now, this article will discuss the detailed syllabus structure for both Tiers followed by the exam pattern.

IB ACIO Selection Process 2025

The selection procedure for IB ACIO 2025 consists of three key stages. The first stage is Tier 1, which is an objective-type written test with 100 questions. Candidates who qualify this round will move on to Tier 2, a descriptive paper that tests writing and comprehension skills.

To move forward, candidates must score at least 33% marks in Tier 2. The final stage is the Interview (Tier 3), where shortlisted candidates are assessed on their personality and suitability for the role. Final selection is based on combined performance in all three tiers.

1. Tier 1 (Phase 1): Objective Type Written Exam (100 Marks)
2. Tier 2 (Phase 2): Descriptive Paper
3. Tier 3 (Phase 3): Personal Interview

Candidates who qualify both Tier I and Tier II will be called for the final round-Tier III, which is a Personal Interview. This stage assesses a candidate's personality, communication skills, and overall suitability for the Intelligence Bureau.

IB ACIO 2025 Final Merit List Criteria

The IB ACIO 2025 selection process involves multiple stages, including Tier-I, Tier-II, and Tier-III (Interview). Each stage has specific qualifying criteria, cut-offs, and shortlisting ratios. The final selection is based on the combined performance across all tiers, subject to verification and medical fitness.

Stage	Details
Tier-I Exam	Objective type exam held in 5 cities chosen by candidate. "Mark for Review" answers not evaluated.
Tier-1 Cut-Off	UR: 35, OBC: 34, SC/ST: 33, EWS: 35. Ex-servicemen will be considered in their respective categories.
Shortlisting for Tier-II	Based on normalized Tier-I scores; 10 times the number of vacancies will be shortlisted, subject to meeting minimum cut-off.
Tier-II Exam	Descriptive paper; candidates must score at least 33% (17 out of 50 marks) to be considered for Tier-III.
Shortlisting for Tier-III	Candidates shortlisted at 5 times the number of vacancies based on combined Tier-I and Tier-II performance.
Final Merit List	Prepared based on combined marks of Tier-I, Tier-II, and Tier-III (Interview).
Post Selection Steps	Includes Character & Antecedent Verification, followed by Medical Examination.
Appointment Type	Initially temporary. Permanent appointment depends on future government rules.
Instructions	Candidates must follow all exam guidelines mentioned in admit cards. Any violation may result in cancellation of candidature.
